CAV Award Winners Announced

The 2014 winner of the Angela Lloyd Book award is Ms. Donna Dollings, teacher at James River High School. Ms. Dollings has shown her dedication to the JCL by attending 9 national conventions and 28 Virginia state conventions. Through her years of teaching she earned multiple honors, including the Jane Crouch Reider award for Excellence in Foreign Language teaching in Chesterfield in 2000 and Teacher of the Year for James River High in 2001. Where Ms. Dollings truely shines in her relationships with her students. In the words of her nominator, "Her genuine compassion is obvious and she quickly puts all at ease.



I have known her to tutor with great success students that others have given up on."



At the spring meeting Mark Keith was named as the second recipient of the Jane Harriman Hall Award for Outstanding Service to the Classical Association of Virginia. This honor comes to Mr. Keith in the same year he was named as the recipient of the Foreign Language Association of Virginia David Cox Award for Excellence in Foreign Language Teaching. Mr. Keith served the CAV as the website editor for seventeen years before turning the task over to Charlaine Lunsford last year. He is also the director for the Lurlene Todd teacher of the year award and was just named the next Vice President of the CAV.

The winner of Wayne Wray student award is Rachel Dubit from Rocbridge County High School. According to her teacher, Mr. Patrick Bradley, there is no more enthusiastic

learner than Rachel and her aptitude with language and literature matches that appetite. She has studied Chinese, Latin, ancient Greek, Italian, and Hebrew. She seemed to take a real delight in every sentence of Latin and once even said she couldn't imagine a life a without Latin! Mr. Bradley noted one of her greatest qualities is that while her level of academic success and knowledge put her far beyond many of her peers, she was always part of the team. Mr. Bradley received Rachel's award on her behalf since she has spent this year at the SYA program in Viterbo, Italy and will be attending The College of William and Mary in the Fall.

Dear Colleagues,

For me, the meeting reaffirmed the crucial position CAV occupies for classics in Virginia. 
