

CAV Latin Tournament – Intermediate Latin Vocabulary

The following lists are meant as both a guide for the test-writer and a resource for the student. Standard words are more frequently seen in textbooks for Latin 2 and will provide the basis for a majority of the questions. Expansion words are intended to challenge students to learn further vocabulary that may not occur in their textbook. Passages may also use recognizable cognates and compounds not listed here (e.g. **theātrum**, **ascendere**, **terribilis**, **con+dūcere**, **dē+currere**) or gloss other words for the reader.
